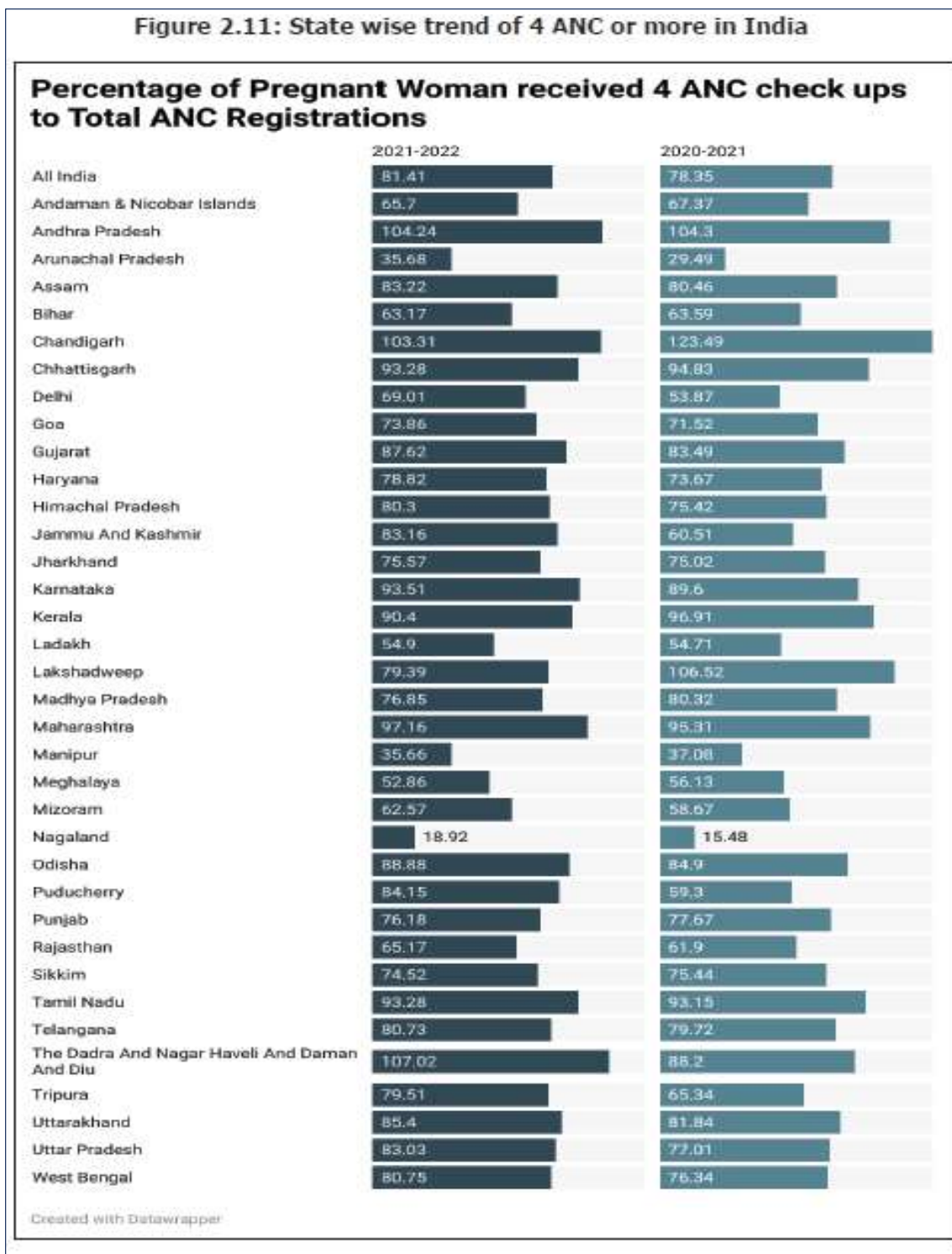


ANC Checkup - States

A5 : Trends of ANC Checkups 4 & more times - (Statewise)



Receiving antenatal care at least four times increases the likelihood of receiving effective maternal health interventions during the antenatal period. This is one of the indicators in the Global Strategy for Women’s, Children’s and Adolescents’ Health (2016-2030) Monitoring Framework, and one of the tracer indicators of health services or the universal health coverage (SDG indicator 3.8.1).

The percentage of states of Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, and Manipur with four or more antenatal check-ups is less than 50% in 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. The performance of twenty-one states are worse than the national average.
