

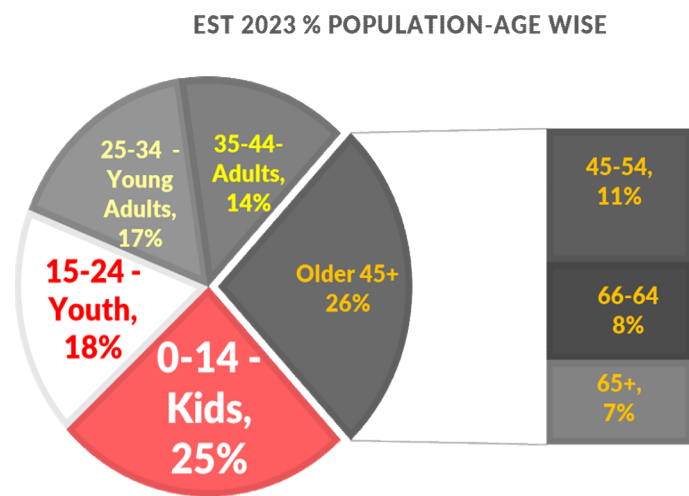
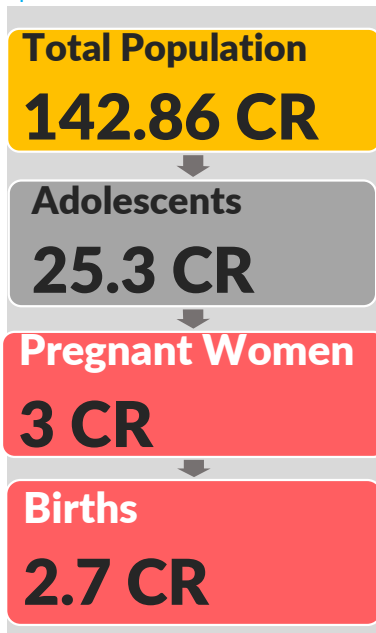

⇒ In India, an estimated **26 millions of children are born every year.**

⇒ Children **0-6 years age group accounts 13%** (as per Census 2011) of the total population of country and nearly one fifth of the world's annual childbirths (as per UNICEF).

⇒ Around **3.5 million babies in India are born too early and more than one million new-borns are discharged each year from Special New-born Care Units (SNCUs).** The newborn delivered early and those who are admitted in SNCU are at high risk and need focused car.
