
## **Demographics**

WHI: Basic Numbers



⇒In India, an estimated 26 millions of children are born every year.

⇒ Children 0-6 years age group accounts 13% (as per Census 2011) of the total population of country and nearly one fifth of the world's annual childbirths (as per UNICEF).

Around 3.5 million babies in India are born too early and more than one million new-borns are discharged each year from Special New-born Care Units (SNCUs). The newborn delivered early and those who are admitted in SNCU are at high risk and need focused car.
