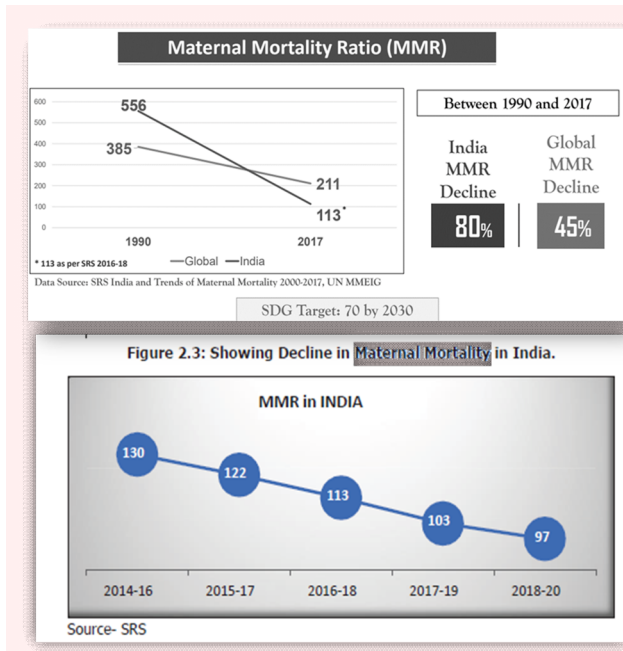


Maternal Mortality Ratio

## Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR) in India

SDG 3: "reducing the global MMR to less than 70 per 100 000 births, with no country having a maternal mortality rate of more than twice the global average".

NHP (National Health Policy) 2017: the target for MMR is 100 per 1,00,000 live births by 2020.
